LECTURE CONTENT WILL INCLUDE SPECIAL TOPICS IN THE HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT OF CHRISTIAN ETHICS, E.G. THEY ARE STUDIED BOTH IN TERMS OF THEIR HISTORICAL AND THEOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT AND THEIR DOCTRINAL AND CONFSSIONAL STANDING FOR ORTHODOX FAITH AND PRACTICE, PARTICULARLY WITHIN ANGLICANISM.
